Until next time enjoy the World Game.

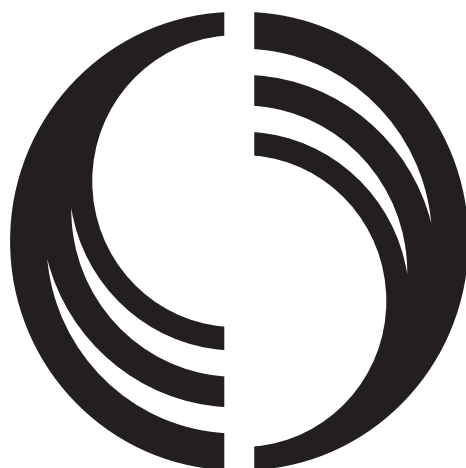

WWSC Committee

Unfortunately this season, some teams are getting a lot of Yellow and Red Cards and the WWSC Committee have requested that one of these teams appear before the disciplinary committee and another team to explain the high number of yellow cards they have received.

To all players Coaches, Managers and Spectators, remember to play the game in a good sportsmanship manner and walk away when there is an incident and always respect the referee and their assistance.

NOTE: If a player has received a Yellow or Red Card during the season, it is the players responsibility to pay the fine for these cards.

\$5 for each Yellow Card and \$10 for each Red Card.

Managers can check with the Club Secretary if you are unsure about your teams

Monies should be collected by the Manager and handed to the Club Secretary.

Any player who has not payed their fines by Round 17, Managers will be asked to hand in the players ID Card to the Club Secretary, which means that the players is ineligible to play until the fines have been paid.

Acceptable Code of Conduct

As in previous editions today we look at the Code of Conduct for Coaches and Manages. With the Semi-Finals just around the corner it can become frustrating at times as teams pursue that semi-final position, So it is very important that all Caches and Managers adhere to the Code of Conduct at all times as you set the standard for your team.

COACHES and MANAGERS

- Remember that children participate for pleasure and that winning is only part of the fun. **Never ridicule or yell at a child** for making a mistake or losing.
- Be **reasonable in your demands** on young players' time, energy and enthusiasm.
- Teach your players to **always follow the rules**, which are unbreakable.
- Whenever possible, group players to ensure that everyone has a reasonable chance of success.
- **Avoid overplaying the talented players.** The just average need and deserve equal time.
- Ensure that equipment and facilities meet **safety standards** and are appropriate to the age and ability of the players.
- **Develop team respect for the ability of opponents** and for the judgement of officials and opposing coaches.
- Follow the **advice of a physician** when determining when an injured player is ready to recommence training or competition.
- **Keep up to date with the latest coaching practices** and the principles of growth and development of children.
