Every player is an integral part of any team and should be treated as so.

It is Your Responsibility to ensure all players within the team are given the opportunity to play EQUAL time each weekend, It is not good enough to have "Little Johnny" or "Mary" sitting on the bench week in week out, just because he or she may not have the ability as the rest of the team.

Please ensure all players get a fair go, as the Time Played on Field are being reviewed after Round 4 and teams will be spoken too who are not doing the right thing by all the kids.

Players Playing Up

Coaches and Managers

In the Coaches and Managers meeting we talked about players playing up, there has been a bit of confusion recently and to clear the matter up the following is correct.

You can only play **2 (Two)** players up in any **1 (One)** game.

A player can only play up for another team/s on 3 Occasions – IF he/she plays a fourth game up, they cannot play again until they have been regarded into a team they played up for and he/she would need to complete the season in this team.

A Player is not permitted to play down in Grade. (Eg 12/2's cannot play 13/3's)

They must comply with the grading requirements.

After the 30th June there is to be NO movement of players at all.

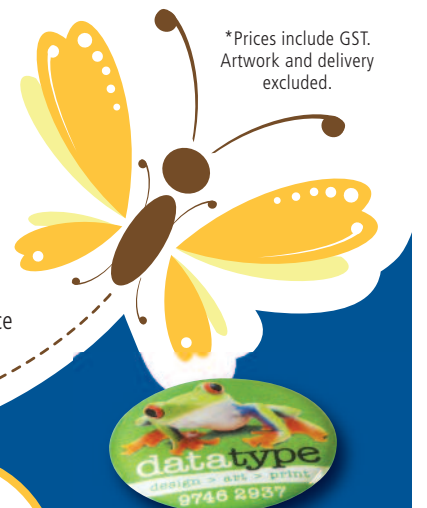
